Declaration times were unclear but it is not anticipated that there will be any declarations prior to 5am. While a consistent approach would be preferred it is accepted that there are various reasons why there may be a variation in the timing of the count across the country.  Size of the Regional Paper  It was noted that some ROs were reporting that due to the printing approach being used, there was some concern that there may be difficulty in ensuring that the Regional paper could accommodation all of the parties / individuals that might wish to stand  ACTION – CH to contact all ROs to address this and stress that the Board wish to ensure that ROs comply with the law and its spirit given that the Scotland Office spent so much time trying to make sue the Ballot paper complied with the principles in the Making Your Mark proposals.
