AS was to circulate further information to all ROs with the output of the testing, scanner allocations technical background etc. Some major issues still need to be resolved, specifically Ballot box design Postal votes, specifically the handling of postal votes where the mailers are being produced by printers other than Opt 2 Vote. Note the Opt2Vote approach to printing – nationally all 4 candidate papers will be printed, then all 5 candidate etc. ACTION all ROs must approve their papers as son as possible or else there is a danger of missing their turns. Invoicing for ballot papers – note that there is also ongoing discussion about the cost of ballot papers – whether the charge will only be for those that are used or whether the cost is for all that authority's allocation. Logica had revised the User Agreement in the light of comments from SOLAR (circulated) and others. This would be circulated to ROs by the end of the week The User Agreement would explicitly recognise that the EDS would develop and change over coming months and that each EDS was to be agreed between Logica and each RO 	ALL
 Count Centre – note that there was still much work to be down around the planning of the Count specifically the length of time that the Count Centres will need to be booked for. Time post count is due to the need to download data from the system.

Many ROs had indicated that their preference was for a Friday count due to advantages in logistics, but that many were also looking to the EMB to offer guidance and perhaps a direction. Issue would be raised with SOLACE Postal Voting - Letter from Highland RO re rejection of postal votes (circulated) Note the issues raised by Highland Council with respect to reasons for the rejection of postal votes / failures on AVI checking Rejection rate is a major concern for politicians but the issues could only really be addressed via a change in the legislation. The data that was analysed by Highland is very valuable and while all ROs generate similar data for post election returns to the Electoral Commission, it needs to be analysed more deeply.
