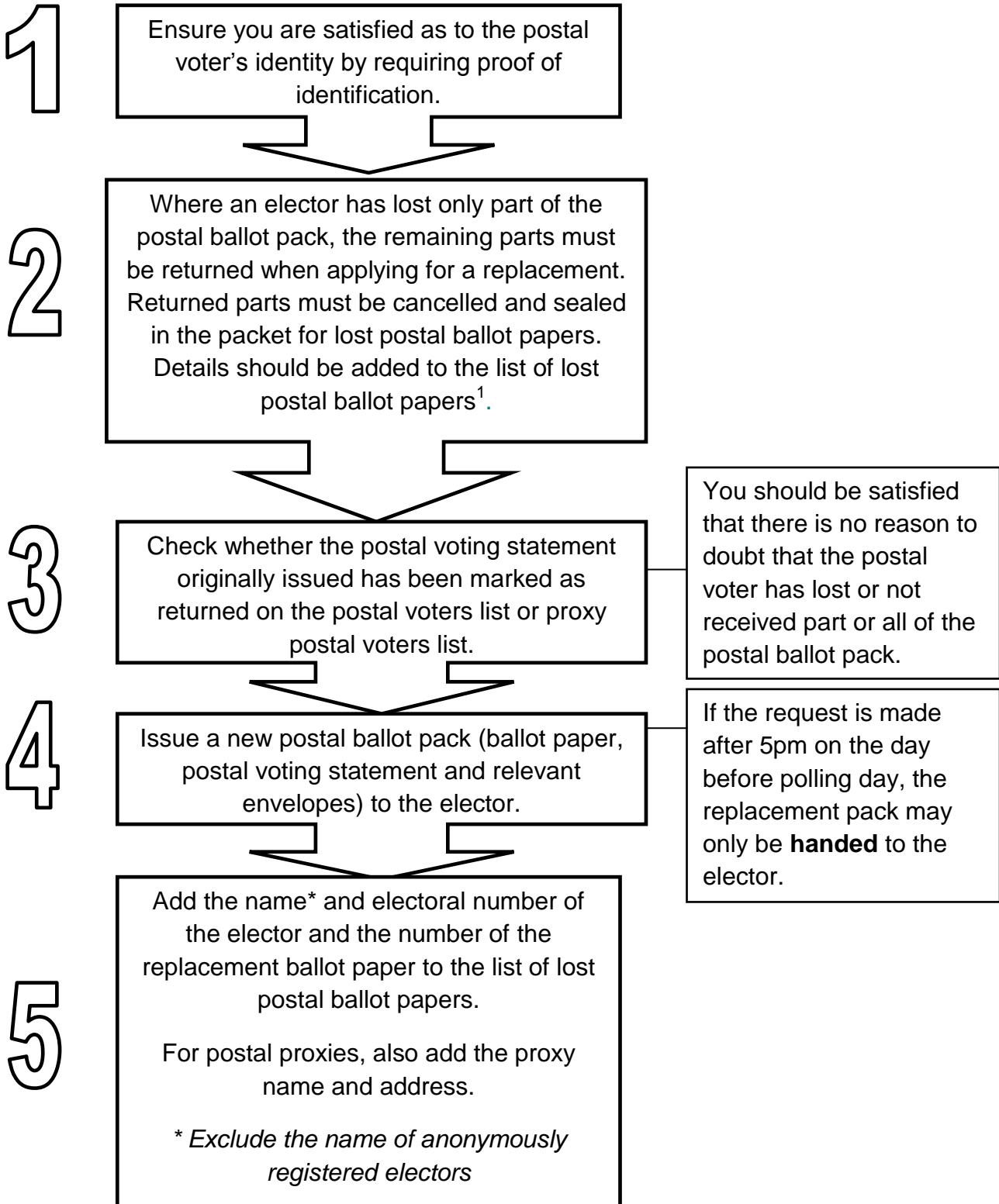


# Scottish Independence Referendum – 18 September 2014

## Re-issuing lost/not received postal votes

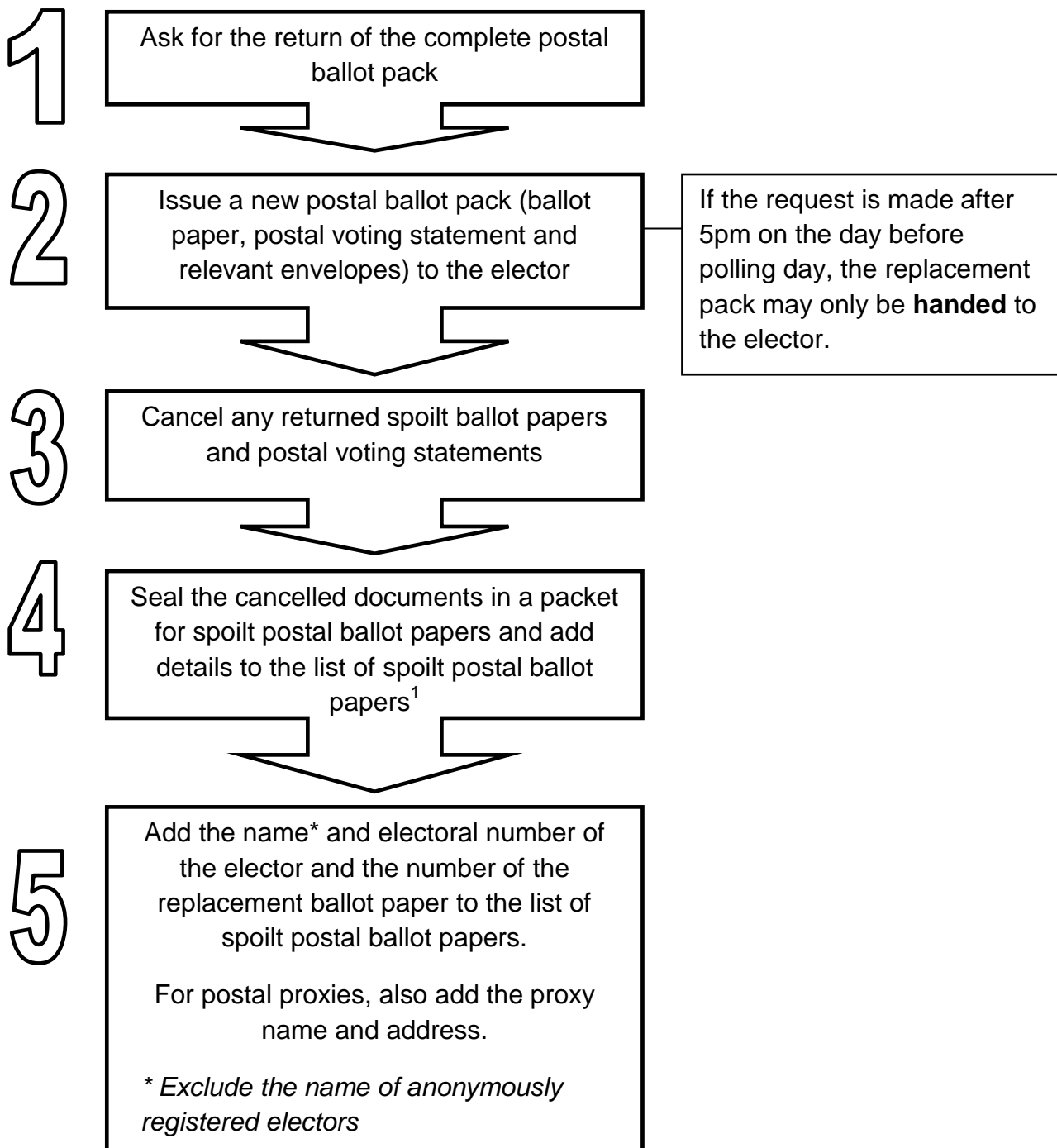


<sup>1</sup> The list of lost postal ballot papers must include the following:

- the name and number of the elector as stated in the polling list (or, in the case of an elector who has an anonymous entry, only their electoral number)
- the number of the lost/cancelled postal ballot paper
- the number of any replacement postal ballot paper that has been issued to the elector
- where the postal voter is a postal proxy, the name and address of the postal proxy

- where the postal voter is a postal proxy, the name and address of the postal proxy
