AON gave an update on the Electoral Commission's Public Awareness campaign including the fact that booklets will be delivered to all households from 3 <sup>rd</sup> - 8 <sup>th</sup> April. The guide will provide information about who can vote, how to register to vote, how to fill in the ballot paper using STV and different ways of voting.	
Following a question from IM, AON agreed to reiterate to political parties again that by law they are not entitled to the same copy of the electoral register as candidates. <b>ACTION</b> : MC to provide the EROs with a paragraph template from the Electoral Commission regarding this fact so that all are giving out the same message. Electoral Registration Officers Update	
PW is not aware of any issues to raise concerns at this stage. IM confirmed that each ERO will supply their RO with the final electorate figures for their local area on 26 April after FIENA.	
AON queried whether it will be possible to view the electorate on a Scottish-wide level. <b>ACTION:</b> DMcG to work with CGI to ensure total electorate available on 27 April. <b>ACTION:</b> DMcG to ensure that the Scottish Government's Q&A includes the RO requirement to submit the final electorate data per Ward on 27 April (for e-count contest files to be finalised). Performance Management Framework	
As previously reported, all Returning Officers have completed the first survey and all have confirmed that they are following the Convener's Directions. MC confirmed that	



the second joint EC/EMB survey regarding polling and the count is due out on 3 April.
AON confirmed that Police Scotland will update MP on Day of Poll of the high level
national picture. There is currently low media interest but is expected to increase by
May. The media will cover local stories of interest.
AON, IM, CH and Richard Jordan (Electoral Commission) attended the SPOC Seminar on 8 March which was a very successful event. It was highlighted that there have been
many personnel changes within Police Scotland. CH confirmed that there has been no
change to the current threat level which remains at severe. There is no specific
intelligence to elections and no enhanced security measures at present but if this
changes then the Board will be notified.
E-Counting Update
Update given by Local Government Liaison Consultant, DMcG. 1300 people have now
been system trained at Pentland House, Edinburgh or Aberdeen which has been well
received. Online materials are available as well as refresher training from CGI in count
week in count venues.
DMcG reported that a Fact Sheet regarding reports to use at the Count will be
distributed shortly. The CGI portal has been refreshed and will be kept up to date and
will have each Q&A included. The summary of data collection following the Close of
Nominations has been circulated. The majority of CGI equipment has arrived in
Livingston (PCs, monitors and most of the servers).
There was a discussion about the average number of candidates standing, breakdown
of parties standing and gender balance within parties. MP stated that the system



		training went very well, the Q&A from the Scottish Government is very useful and that there is a feeling that there is quite a high level of turnover of Councillors this year.
