You will receive a separate email on this on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> October.</li> <li>• <b>eCounting Regional Managers - Count Centre Surveys/Visits</b> – Surveys/visits are ongoing - thanks for your co-operation and ongoing negotiations.</li> </ul> <p><b>User Acceptance Testing (UAT)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We are pleased to advise the User Acceptance Testing was undertaken on 19<sup>th</sup> October and the User representatives in attendance were happy to accept the system. All user facing elements of the system have now been signed off.</li> </ul> <p><b>Performance Testing</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The final system performance tests, involving over 150k ballots, will be undertaken at the end of November. One 150k test has already taken place - the system performed very well and no issues have been identified. User group representatives will be invited to attend these tests if they wish to see the system operating at scale. The final tests will aim to mimic a real count, including the production of all reports and all data extraction processes.</li> </ul>
