	• Equipment Levels – Some discussions between councils and their Fujitsu Regional Managers are ongoing to confirm equipment requirements. It is hoped this will be concluded by the end of this year.

	Easyprint Training Easyprint Training started on Monday 15 November with almost all Councils taking up the offer of training which is progressing well and should be concluded by Thursday 9 December 2022.
	Performance Testing The final system performance tests, involving over 150k ballots, will be undertaken on 24 and 25 November in Silvan House, Edinburgh.
	Council Q&As The previous successful and well received practice of providing an ongoing Q&As document to councils is being repeated in preparation for May 2022 with the first version of this document accompanying this Bulletin. The Q&A is a fairly detailed document which aims to address all manner of practical questions around eCounting and matters related to it. As time goes on the Q&A will grow (we won't delete items) and this will hopefully provide a useful resource for all ROs and their election teams.

Info eCount By-elections

Many of you will already be aware there are 4 Scottish Local Government Byelection eCounts scheduled to take place by the end of January 2022 which will use the same solution of eCount system as will be used in May 2022. The Byelection eCounts are as follows:-

- Friday 3 December 2021 at 2pm Highland Council (Fort William)
- Tuesday 14 December 2021 at 10pm Renfrewshire Council (Paisley)
- Thursday 16 December 2021 at 10pm Argyll & Bute Council (Helensburgh)
- Friday 20 January 2021 at 9am East Lothian (Preston/Seton/Gosford)

I am sure you will be interested in the successful delivery of these eCounts and therefore an update will be provided in a future issue of the Bulletin.

Forthcoming Briefing Event

 Thursday 27 January 2022 – Many of you will already be aware the EMB is holding a Joint Seminar with the Electoral Commission for ROs and EROs on Thursday 27 January 2022 which will address a range of issues relating to your planning and delivery of the elections next year.
