	<ul> <li>Easyprint – All councils have locked down their EasyPrint order and signed off their envelopes, all mailers have been completed, proofed and signed off, 90% of councils envelopes have been approved by Royal Mail. The next major date in the print timetable is the mock election which will commence on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> February, however if any council wishes to provide the data early, we will be in a position to accept it.
